Each performance will integrate characters (major and minor), theme, newly acquired vocabulary, and a "Historical Background Spot" or a commentary reflecting on a historical event that influences a character or the action.

As a group you will be discussing the various roles for each member including technical expert, sound effects person, actor/actress etc. Taking into account your strengths and weaknesses, you will decide what job best fits your personality.
